Larry W. Edelman is vice president of operations for Northrop Grumman's Information Systems sector, an approximately \$10 billion leading global provider of advanced solutions for defense, intelligence, civil agency, state and local and commercial customers. In this role, Larry is responsible for helping achieve the sector's financial, growth and operational excellence objectives.

Mr. Edelman has held a wide array of positions with increasing levels of responsibility at Northrop Grumman and TRW (acquired by Northrop Grumman in December 2002). Prior to his current position, Mr. Edelman was sector vice president of planning and development for Northrop Grumman's Mission Systems sector, responsible for strategic planning, portfolio management and mergers and acquisitions.

Earlier, he was director of planning and analysis, then director of investor relations for TRW Inc., in Cleveland, Ohio, and later was director of planning and strategic development for TRW's Aerospace and Information Systems sector.

Mr. Edelman joined TRW as division pricing manager for the Defense Products division in the Space and Electronics group in Redondo Beach, Calif., then became group director of pricing, then program operations manager for the SBIRS-Low program, then director of finance for group operations, and then director of finance for the Civil & International Systems division.

Prior to joining TRW, Mr. Edelman worked at Sundstrand Corporation, Litton Inc., and Teledyne Inc., in a broad array of financial and operation positions. In addition, he was an instructor at UCLA from 1983 to 1995.

Mr. Edelman earned a Bachelor of Science in accounting from Northern Illinois University and a master's degree in business administration from Pepperdine University. He is also a graduate of the University of Southern California Management Policy Institute.
